



Commingled Recycling

The City of Santa Monica Solid Waste Division is designing a **commingled** recycling program for all Santa Monica residents, where cans, bottles and paper can be placed in one container for collection.

As part of this effort, the City of Santa Monica is expanding the collection program in your neighborhood. Please look for the large, blue recycling containers strategically placed in your alley near your regular trash containers.



Look what can be recycled in the *new* Commingled Recycling Containers:

YES

- Glass Bottles and Jars (all colors)
- Plastic Containers Coded 1-5 
- Aluminum Cans
- Steel Cans
- *Empty* Aerosol Cans
- Wire Hangers
- White, Colored and Computer Paper
- Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs
- Junk Mail, Envelopes
- Telephone Books
- Cereal Boxes, Gift Boxes
- *Flattened* Cardboard Boxes

Sorry but the following items **cannot** be recycled in this program:

NO

- Light bulbs
- Plate or Window Glass
- Pyrex
- Hazardous Materials
- Batteries
- Household Appliances
